

PRIX D'AMÉRIQUE RACES ZETURF: TWO MORE CHAMPIONS QUALIFIED AFTER THE RACE QUALIF #5 PRIX DE BOURGOGNE



The Prix d'Amérique Races ZEturf QUALIF #5 Prix de Bourgogne has provided an exciting confrontation. Both favourites put on a great show and **Face Time Bourbon**, the punter's favourite, won the Group II Race. **Vivid Wise As**, second, and **Délia du Pommereux**, third, have brilliantly passed their qualification test for the Ultimate Prix d'Amérique Races ZEturf: the three top races, the Prix d'Amérique Legend Race, the Prix de France Speed Race et the Prix de Paris Marathon Race.



The favourites have held their own in the Prix d'Amérique Races ZEturf QUALIF #5 Prix de Bourgogne. Logically, **Face Time Bourbon** started with highly confident odds. The 2020 Prix d'Amérique winner had made a strong impression with his first place in the QUALIF #2 Prix du Bourbonnais on 13 December. His main designated opponent was to be **Davidson du Pont** who had beaten him in the last Grand Prix de France. In the *Prix de Bourgogne*, the fight between these two great champions was superb. It lasted up to mid-stretch, when **Fast Time Bourbon** put his foot down and took a final advantage. His rival gave in slightly and arrived fourth.

Vivid Wise As and **Délia du Pommereux** completed the podium. Both are joining **Diabre de Vauvert**, **Feliciano**, **Bahia Quesnot**, the above mentioned **Face Time Bourbon**, **Victor Ferm**, **Moni Viking**, **Gu d'Héripuré** and **Féérie Wood** among the qualified runners for the Ultimate Prix d'Amérique Races ZEturf : Prix d'Amérique Legend Race, Prix de France Speed Race and Prix de Paris Marathon Race.



Björn Goop, **Face Time Bourbon's** driver, did not hide his joy and told Equidia :*"This is wonderful, it is a driver's dream to be associated to such a champion. Today, he was not at his best but he will be in four weeks' time. He always wants to win. Today, I had very good feelings indeed"*. Mentor Sebastian Guarato added: *"We had some emotions towards the end, the last meters were difficult. He will be better, hidden in the pack, in the great final, within four weeks. Only a very strong horse can beat him."* Jean-Michel Bazire, trainer-driver of Davidson du Pont explained: *"« He is going to improve after this nice fourth place, it is encouraging for the future. He was just short of some competition."*

Next rendez-vous for the competition Prix d'Amérique Races ZEturf : Sunday 17 January with the QUALIF #6 Prix de Belgique, the last Qualification race before the Prix d'Amérique Legend Race.
