

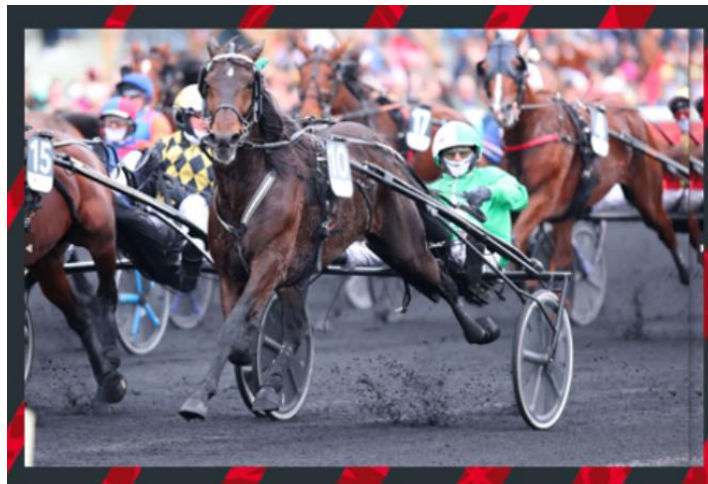
PRIX DE BRETAGNE – AMÉRIQUE RACES Q#1 - HUSSARD DU LANDRET, SAN MOTEUR,  
HOOKER BERRY AND JUST LOVE QUALIFY FOR THE FINALS

Eighteen top trotters, aged 4 to 10, launched the journey to the prestigious **Prix d'Amérique Legend Race** in a heart-stopping **Prix de Bretagne - Amérique Races Q#1**. This thrilling first race awarded four coveted spots in the ultimate harness trotting showdown.

**Hussard du Landret**, last year's **Prix de Bretagne - Amérique Races Q#1** champion, retained his title, once again proving his dominance. Joining him on the road to Paris-Vincennes victory were **San Moteur**, **Hooker Berry**, and **Just Love You**. The four champions secured their tickets not only for the **Prix d'Amérique Legend Race** (January 26, 2025) but also for the **Prix de France Speed Race** (February 9) and the **Prix de Paris Marathon Race** (February 23).



**Hussard du Landret**, winner of the **Prix de Bretagne - Amérique Races Q#1**, and his driver Yoann Lebourgeois

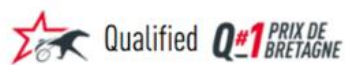
**Banderas Bi** was quick to lead the pack, but the battle got underway with one lap to go under the guidance of **Josh Power** and **San Moteur**. **Hussard du Landret** gradually closed in on **San Moteur**, with Eric Raffin, just on the outside with **Josh Power**. An epic duel began between **San Moteur** and **Hussard du Landret**, who completed the race with a time of 1'11"4, But Benoît Robin's champion gave nothing away, retaining the lead by a nose at the post. In third place was **Hooker Berry**, known for his sprinting talent, who crossed the line a length behind the two leaders. Just behind was **Just Love You**,

the protégé of the Abrivard family, who narrowly snatched the last winning ticket of the day from **Banderas Bi**.



Yoann Lebourgeois, the day's winning driver, told Equidia: *"Benoît Robin just told me to do as I pleased. I thought I was ahead but then I saw Björn Goop and San Moteur gain speed so I surged in front. And when he's in the lead, he's very strong."*

The winner's trainer, Benoît Robin, then commented: *"We're so relieved. He's aged a year, and we didn't know if we'd get him back completely. It's just great to be lucky enough to have such a great horse."*






